**2009 EXAMINATION EARLY REGISTRATION DEADLINE**

**Washington, D.C.** – Early Bird Registrations for the 26 September 2009 Worldwide IICL Inspector Certification Examinations will end on Monday, 1 June 2009. Early registration rates are \$300 for the container test and \$225 for the Chassis.

Candidates may also continue to register for the examinations at the regular registration period rates of \$350 for the container test and \$250 for the chassis test until August 9th. A late registration period extends from 10 August to 4 September with registration fees of \$375 for the container exam and \$275 for the chassis.

Candidates interested in registering may do so online via IICL's website [www.iicl.org](http://www.iicl.org) Test Information Bulletins, sample questions and a list of test centers are also available at IICL's website for both examinations.

The Container Inspector's Examination tests knowledge of IICL criteria in container inspection and repair, while the chassis exam focuses on IICL recommendations on chassis inspections and maintenance and U.S. government regulations. Candidates who pass the examination will be awarded IICL certificates, photo-identification cards and will have their names listed in the IICL Online Inspection Directory for a five year period.

The 2009 Container examination is based on the Full Set of Container Inspection Publications (six manuals), the Convention for Safe Container pamphlet, and IICL Technical Bulletin 002: Electronic Data Interchange Standards (EDIS). The Guide for Chassis Inspection & Maintenance, 4<sup>th</sup> edition is the only manual required to study for the chassis examination.

The 2009 chassis exam will also include questions relating to the recently released FMCSA roadability regulations. These additional questions will be based upon an IICL chassis technical bulletin (TB 007 – IICL Owner/IEP Best Practices) located on our web site.
